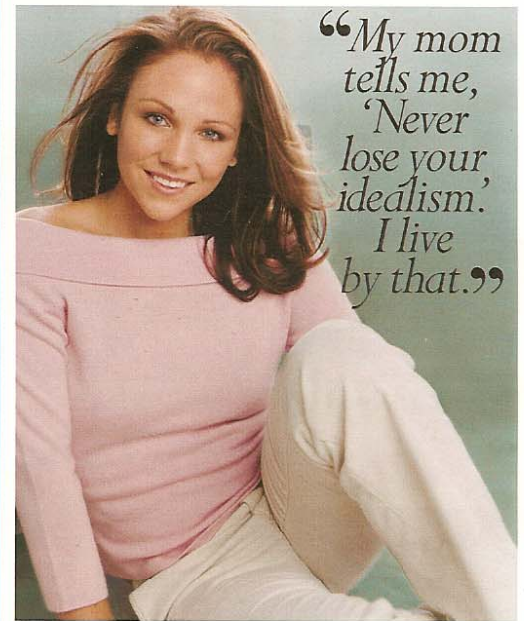

# The educator

## KERSTIN ERICKSON

**Age:** 21 **School:** Stanford University, Palo Alto, California **Major:** Public policy **Her brilliant résumé:** Four years ago, Erickson and her family took a life-changing safari vacation to Kenya. "It really shocked my senses to see the depth of suffering there," she says. She swore she'd return as a teacher, and last year, the Santa Rosa, California, native made good on that plan. After studying Swahili, Erickson returned to Africa to teach literacy at a refugee camp in Botswana, and then created FORGE, an organization that connects college students with young refugees in camps. **Dream job:** To work in refugee education. **How she unwinds:** Playing basketball. **Role model:** Nelson Mandela. "He refused to give up, even in the face of the worst odds."
